## Beach Street CHURCH OF CHRIST Fort Worth, TX

To all the saints at *Beach Street*, with the elders and deacons:

Esteemed brethren,

Glad to inform you that we are doing well and staying busy – and ready for Thanksgiving Day. Following is my report on my work with the *Gómez Farías* congregation in **Guadalajara, Mexico** and on my meeting in December. Also, you will see my updated, but tentative, preaching schedule for the coming months of 2025.

### Guadalajara, Jalisco, México – November 3rd-8th.

I had a safe trip to **Guadalajara** to labor with the *Gómez Farías* congregation – the oldest of the sound churches in Guadalajara. Their meeting place is near the historic downtown area of this beautiful city. *Samuel Ibarra* is one of several men assisting in the teaching work of the local church. A dedicated Christian.



In addition to the regular worship assemblies Sunday through Friday, I taught five Bible classes from **1 Peter** at 6pm, Monday through Friday before the evening assemblies. Following are the English titles of the sermons I preached in Spanish during the worship assemblies: 1) *Dorcas*; 2) *Epaphras*; 3) *Judas*; 4) *Angels in the Work of Conversion*; 5) *Timothy*; 6) *The Multitude of Believers*; 7) *Gaius*; 8) *The Other Heroes of Faith*.

Attendance was good throughout the week with several non-Christian visitors and Christians from area congregations in attendance. I was informed about two months prior to our meeting that the city was suffering from the Dengue epidemic. Several members and their families contracted the illness and were not able to attend the meeting. Nevertheless, it was a good week and work.

Friday night, the last night of the meeting, *Rosy*, wife of *Saúl Ramón* (left photo), came forward to confess her faith in Jesus as the Son of God and

to express her willingness to be baptized for the remission of her sins. This was a beautiful surprise to all in attendance. Rosy was a devoted Catholic. Saúl and *Nuvia* (their only daughter) are faithful Christians. Saúl is one of the young men who actively serves the congregation. Saúl's parents are faithful Christians – the whole family is highly regarded by the members at Gómez Farías. Please remember this young lady, her family, and the whole congregation in your prayers. The whole church expressed their gratitude to all who make my work possible.

### Remaining Preaching Trips & Gospel Meetings In 2024.

- **December 3rd-8th**, is the date I will be with the **Flagler Grove** Spanish-speaking congregation in **Miami, Florida**. My good friend, *Iván Palomino*, is serving the local church as their evangelist. The Flagler Grove church is the only sound Spanish-speaking congregation in South Florida.

### Preaching Trips & Gospel Meetings Schedule for 2025.

- **January 15th-24th**, plans call for me to be with the church in **Alajuela**, Costa Rica.
- **February 18th-27th**, is the date of my preaching trip to **Buenos Aires**, Argentina, where I will be with the local church in **Moreno**, a suburb of Buenos Aires.
- **March 16th-21st**, I will be holding a gospel meeting with the **University Heights** congregation in Lexington, Kentucky.
- **April 7th-18th**, plans are to travel to **Peru**, South America. Working with local churches in the northern sector of Peru (**Catacaos, Paíta, and Piura**).
- **April 29th-May 4th**, is the date for my meeting with the new congregation in the sector of **Iztapalapa**, in **Mexico City**. *Noé Bautista* is one of several men who serve the church as teachers and preachers.
- **May 14th-23rd**, plans are to be in Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic, working with *Arcadio Mañón Ozuna* and *El Mamón* congregation.
- **September 29th-October 8th**, I will be with the churches in Seville and Dos Hermanas, Spain.

### In Closing.

I am profoundly thankful for your fellowship. For a good number of years, you have partnered with me in this valuable work of evangelism. Countless people have heard and obeyed the gospel because of our combined efforts of preaching Christ. Local churches in Latin America and in the USA exist because of our combined and dedicated efforts. Your support makes it possible to continue this work.
