Ten Virgins = Purified in obedience to the truth

(I Pt 1: 22; II Cor 11:2)

Lamps = Faith and works

(Matt 5:14-16)

Parable of the Ten Virgins (Matthew 25:1-13)

Bridegroom = Jesus Christ
(Matt 9:15)

Foolish = Unprepared

Prudent = Prepared

Parable of the Ten Virgins (Matthew 25:1-13)

Oil = Works filled with the Spirit

(I Sam 10:1; 16:12-14)

Bridegroom delaying = Grace of God

(II Pt 3:9)

All fell into sleep = Lack of diligence

(Eph 5:11-17; Rms 13:11-14; I Thes 5:4-6; Heb 6:11-12)

Midnight cry = Call to judgment
(Matt 24: 42-45; Lk 12: 35-40)

Trimmed their lamps = Self examination
(II Cor 13: 5)

Refusal to give oil = righteousness is not transferrable
(Gal 6:4; I Pt 1: 17)

(Rev 19: 7-9)

Door was shut =
