1. Outline Mark 7.

2. Mark 7:1-13. Jesus condemns the Jewish tradition of “washing of hands”. Was it wrong to wash hands before eating? What was the issue?

3. What are some traditions that Jesus kept? some He violated?

4. What made their traditions wrong?

5. Are traditions in the Bible approved? What makes a tradition “good” or “bad”?

6. Mark 7:14-23. What was the point of the parable?
7. What do the sins listed in v.21-22 have in common?
8. What is the inverse application of v.23?
9. Mark 7:24-30. What did the nature of her request indicate that she believed about Jesus?
10. Application: Compare our faith in Jesus as exemplified by our attitude toward Him and approach to Him in prayer - how does our faith compare with the Canaanite woman?
11. What do we learn about Jesus from this incident?
12. Mark 7:31-37. Jesus once again tells them "not to tell anyone". Are they doing wrong by continuing "to proclaim it"?
