3. What exception was given by Moses? Does Jesus make application of that exception for today?

4. Mark 10:13-16. What does it mean that little children "for the kingdom of God belongs to such as these"?

5. Mark 10:17-27. Did this rich man worship Jesus? How do you know?

6. Why was the man sad? What does this show about his true allegiance?

7. Is it wrong to have wealth/riches? Why Jesus' warning?

8. Mark 10:28-31. Is it ok to "leave" responsibility of husband/wife, parents, etc. for Jesus' sake? Why?

9. Explain the figure of speech in v.30. Will we literally receive 100 fold of these things in the present age if we leave them for the gospel's sake?

10. Mark 10:35-45. James and John seek prestige. Where they thinking on physical or spiritual matters in regards to Jesus' kingdom?

11. What is said one should be if he wishes to be great? What is the lesson for us?

12. Mark 10:46-52. Jesus heals a blind man. Matthew 20:29-34 records that there were two blind men. Is that a contradiction? Why or why not?

13. Mark 11:1-10. What was the reaction of Jesus entering Jerusalem?

14. Mark 11:11-14. Why did Jesus curse the fig tree?
