3. Galatians 5:19. How is "carousing" (NASB) translated in other translations.

4. 1 Peter 4:3-5. What may make it difficult to abstain from the things listed here? What will be the consequence of practicing these things?

5. 1 Peter 4:3-5. How are "drunkenness", "carousing", "drinking parties" (NASB) translated in other translations?

6. Proverbs 23:29-35. How does the proverb describe those who “linger over” or “taste” the “wine” or “mixed wine”?

7. Isaiah 28:7. What are the characteristics of drinking wine in this text?

8. How should the Christian view/protect their mind/heart/thinking? and for what purpose? (Romans 12:2; Hebrews 8:10)

9. Genesis 19:31-35. How do you make someone to drink? Why did Lot allow himself to get drunk?

10. Genesis 19:31-35. Where did Lot’s daughters learn such wickedness?

11. What should be the view about drunkenness and carousing?
