Questions will be discussed in class. Use this for notes/further study.

1. Define jealousy and envy (including from a dictionary and the original word in Gal 5).

2. Explain how the word jealousy (Strong's G2205) is used in Acts 13:45; Romans 10:2; 2 Corinthians 7:7; 2 Corinthians 11:2.

3. Explain how the word envy (Strong's G5355) is used in Matthew 27:18; Phillipians 1:15; Titus 3:#; 1 Peter 2:1; James 4:5

4. According to the previous 2 questions, is jealousy and envy always bad? Explain.

5. Romans 11:11-16. Why was Paul encouraging them to be jealous? Is there contradiction with his instruction in Romans 13:13?

6. 1 Corinthians 3:1-3. What caused Paul's understanding that they were worldly? Why did he come to the conclusion that they were of the world?

7. 2 Corinthians 12:20. What was Paul fearful that he would find if he came to them?

8. In what ways were the Corinthians envious and jealous towards one another?

9. 1 Samuel 8:1-10. How were the children of Israel envious? Did they really understand what they were envious of (v.11-22)?

- 10.1 Samuel 18:6-21. Because of his envy, what did Saul do to David?

11. James 3:14-16. What is wisdom in the context? What are the fruits of this wisdom?
