Have you ever considered that how dependent you are upon God may be a result of your humbleness, or lack thereof? My prayer is that after reading Deuteronomy 4 and John 15 we may consider 2 very important concepts to being a humble servant of God.

1) God's Test for Israel - Deuteronomy 4:2-4, 10-20

A. 2 Concepts To Be Humble

- 1) Total Dependence (v.2-3, 9)
- 2) Fear (4)

B. God's Expectations (10-20)

- 1) Believe without seeing (12) (Hebrews 11:1; 1 John 5:1-6, 13)
- 2) Continue to obey after the blessing (14) (Romans 6:1-7)
- 3) "Watch yourselves" (15-19) (1 Peter 5:8; Matthew 24:34-44; 1 Corinthians 15:58)
- 4) Remember your Father (20) (Titus 2:11-14)

A. 2 Concepts To Be Humble

- 1) Total Dependence (1-5)
- 2) Fear (6)

B. If We Abide In Christ...

- 1) Be like the vine (James 3:11-12)
- 2) "Bear much fruit" (8)
- 3) Allow pruning (2)
- 4) Glorify God (8)

We do not become totally dependent humble servants by...

- Just becoming Christians
- Wishing for it
- Failing to do evil

What must I do to be saved?

Believe: Hebrews 11:6, Acts 18:8. Repent: Matthew 4:17, Acts 17:30-31.

Confess: Mat. 10:32-33, John 11:25-27. Be Baptized: Mat. 28:19, Acts 2:38, 1 Peter 3:21.
