A. 1 Samuel 15:1-3

1) King Saul clearly heard and understood.

B. Agrees to It Out Of Love For God. (1 Samuel 9:2, 14-17)

1) King Saul constantly sought after God.

- 1 Samuel 9:6 – *“there is a man of God in this city... all that he says surely comes true”*
- 13:8 – *“Now he waited seven days, according to the appointed time set by Samuel...”*
- 15:13 – *“the command of the Lord...”*
- 15:27&30 – *“Saul seized the edge of his robe... please honor me now before the elders...”*
- 28:11 – *“...Bring up Samuel for me.”*

3) Serves Two Masters (Matthew 6:24)

A. Is Torn Between God and Man 1 Samuel 15:

- 1) V.12 – *“he set up a monument for himself”*
- 2) V. 13 – *“I have carried out the command of the Lord.”*
- 3) V. 15 – *“They have brought them ... the people spared the best”*
- 4) V. 21 – *“but the people took...”*
- 5) V. 24 – *“because I feared the people and listened to their voice.”*

B. The Result Is:

- 1) V. 24-25 – Guilt over not being faithful to God.
- 2) V. 10-11{35}, 26-29 – God’s justice will be executed.
