- How do we obtain it? (Matthew 5:6; 1 Corinthians 15:33-34)

2) Go To Battle With:

A. Faith (Heb. 11:1 - "Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen.")

- Faith Allows You To:
 - Begin fighting
 - Take "missiles"

B. Salvation (Mark 16:16; 1 Peter 3:21)

C. Sword of The Spirit (Hebrews 4:12; Matthew 4:4,7,10)

Will you **confess** that Jesus is the Lord of your life? ([Matthew 16:16](#); [Romans 10.9-10](#)).

Will you die with Christ by surrendering to Him in the **water of baptism**? ([Acts 2:38](#); [22:16](#) ; [John 3:5](#); [Romans 6:3-6](#)).
