1) Question & Answer - Psalm 119:9-16

A. Question:

- 1) How can a young man keep his way pure?

B. Answer:

- 1) v.9 – by keeping our way according to His word.
- 2) v. 10 – Seeking God with all our heart (Matthew 7:7-11).
- 3) v.14 – Rejoicing in His Truths (Romans 1:1-14).
- 4) v. 15 – Meditating & Respecting His Truths.
- 5) v. 16 – Delighting in Truth and Not Forgetting What We Have Learned.
- 6) v. 11 – Treasure Truth in Our Heart.

2) Question & Answer - 1 John 1 -3

A. Question:

- 1) How does one escape sin, darkness, the devil?

B. Answer:

- 1) 1:5-7 – Walk in “*the light.*”
- 2) v.10 – 2:2 – Confess your sins.
- 3) 2:3-6 – “*keep His commandments*” “*abide/walk in Him*”
- 4) 2:15-17, 24 – obey the “*will of God.*”
- 5) 3:4-9 – The “Seed” is His Word.
