- 1) Thinking Too Worldly Caused Them to Continue in Sin.
- 2) The Inability to Self-Reflect Is Not An Excuse.

- 1) Overconfidence Caused Him to Sin. (1 Cor. 10:12; 1 Peter 5:6-9)

#### **A. Warnings**

- 1) Looking At The Sins of Others (Matthew 7:3-5)

### **Matthew 7:3-5**

Why do you look at the speck that is in your brother's eye, but do not notice the log that is in your own eye? <sup>4</sup>Or how can you say to your brother, 'Let me take the speck out of your eye,' and behold, the log is in your own eye? <sup>5</sup>You hypocrite, first take the log out of your own eye, and then you will see clearly to take the speck out of your brother's eye.

### **Galatians 6:7-8**

Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, this he will also reap. <sup>8</sup>For the one who sows to his own flesh will from the flesh reap corruption, but the one who sows to the Spirit will from the Spirit reap eternal life.
