### A. Matthew 5:3-12:

- 1) **"poor in spirit"** - quality of recognizing our spiritual poverty without God.
- 2) **"those who mourn"** - quality of hating sin in our lives & in the world.
- 3) **"the gentle"** - quality of being humble & meek.
- 4) **"who hunger & thirst for righteousness"** - quality of desiring the only water that can truly quench our thirst.
- 5) **"the merciful"** - quality of being kind & forgiving.
- 6) **"pure in heart"** - quality of allowing God's word to purify you.
- 7) **"the peacemakers"** - quality of bringing peace spiritually & physically.
