Fight The Good Fight – Choose Your Side

"I call heaven and earth to witness against you today, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and curse. Therefore choose life, that you and your offspring may live," (*Deuteronomy 30:19 - NKJV*)

1) Personal Failure

A. Jehoshaphat Creates Alliance with Ahab

Consequences:

- 1) Defeat (1 Chron. 18:28-34)
- 2) Feared Death (v.31)

B. Jehoshaphat Creates Alliance with Ahaziah

Consequences:

- 1) Lost his investment (1 Chron. 20:35-37)

2) Failure Within Family

A. Jehoshaphat Creates Alliance with Ahab

Consequences:

- 1) Spiritually dead son (2 Chron. 21:1, 4, 12-15, 19-20)
- 2) Spiritually dead grandson (22:2-4)
- 3) Physically dead sons (21:4)
- 4) Physically dead grandsons (22:10-12)

3) Failure For Others

A. Jehoshaphat Creates Alliance with Ahab

Consequences

- 1) Lives of those soldiers (2 Chron. 18:28-34; 19:2-3)
- 2) Spiritual influence on others (2 Kings 11:18; 2 Chron. 24:4-7)

Notes:

What must I do to be saved?

Do you **believe** that Jesus is the Son of God and able to save you from your sin? (Hebrews 11:6; John 3:16).

Will you **commit** to a new way of life, **repent** and leave your old way behind? (Acts 17:30).

Will you **confess** that Jesus is the Lord of your life? (Matthew 16:16; Romans 10:9-10).

Will you **die with Christ** by surrendering to Him in the water of **baptism**? (Acts 2:38; 22:16; Romans 6:3-6; 1 Peter 3:21)
