9. A ruler of a synagogue who became a Christian (18:8).
10. Took a preacher aside and explained to him the way of God more accurately (18:24-26).
11. Two men from Jerusalem who went with Paul and Barnabas to Antioch, to deliver the decrees determined by the apostles and elders in Jerusalem. Hint: These two men were described as prophets (15:30-34).
12. He was stopped from killing himself (16:27-28).
13. Nodded off and then fell off (20:9).
14. Proconsul of Achaia who drove the Jews from the judgment seat when they tried to accuse Paul (18:14-16).
15. Three who spoke at the meeting about circumcision, other than Peter (15:12-21).

9. People who were baptized with John's baptism were baptized in the name of Jesus.
10. Paul preaches about an appointed day when Jesus will judge the world.
11. Disciples meeting together on the first day of the week.
