3. What is a Christian’s relationship to righteousness? (Romans 6:18-19).

13. With what kind of water will Jesus quench our thirst? (John 4:13-14).
14. With what should a Christian desire to be filled? (Philippians 1:11; Colossians 1:9-10; Ephesians 3:19).
