# Manner of Praise

- Joyfully and wholeheartedly (63:5; 9:1).
- With understanding (47:7).
- Continually (34:1; 104:33).
- With both my mouth and my conduct (50:23).
- Needs to be specific...

# Specific Praise

- For His marvelous works (9:1; 40:5; 139:14).
- For His word (33:1, 4; 119).
- For His creation (33:6-9).
- For the many blessings He has bestowed on us, including forgiveness (68:19; 51:13-14; 103:2-3; 130:3-4).
- For answering our prayers (66:18-20).
- For His many wonderful attributes—lovingkindness, mercy, compassion, faithfulness, power, etc.

# God's View of Such Praise

- Good, pleasant, and beautiful (33:1; 147:1).
- A sweet smelling aroma, an acceptable sacrifice, well pleasing to Him (Phil. 4:19; Heb. 13:16).
