**Heb 10:25** not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as is the manner of some, but exhorting one another, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching.

An example of confession **Ac 8:37** Then Philip said, "If you believe with all your heart, you may." And he answered and said, "I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God."

- Baptism passages? **Mk 16:16** "He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned.

Verse that tells us how to call on the name of the Lord after being told to Call on the name in **Acts. 2:21** they asked what they must do? Acts. 2:38 Repent and be baptized.

**Ac 22:16** 'And now why are you waiting? Arise and be baptized, and wash away your sins, calling on the name of the Lord.'

**Psalm 145:18** The LORD is near to all who call upon Him, To all who call upon Him in truth.

- Prove that baptism is immersion **Acts. 8** Phillip and Eunuch went down into the water and came up out of the water. **Rom. 6:3-4** Baptism in likeness of death " a burial".

- Where are we told to contend earnestly for the truth which was once for all delivered to the saints. **Jude 1:3**

-**2Pe 1:5-11** ¶ But also for this very reason, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue, to virtue knowledge, 6 to knowledge self-control, to self-control perseverance, to perseverance godliness, 7 to godliness brotherly kindness, and to brotherly kindness love. 8 For if these things are yours and abound, you will be neither barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. 9 For he who lacks these things is shortsighted, even to blindness, and has forgotten that he was cleansed from his old sins. 10 Therefore, brethren, be even more diligent to make your call and election sure, for if you do these things you will never stumble; 11 for so an entrance will be supplied to you abundantly into the everlasting kingdom of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ

-**2 Thess. 1:7-9** and to give you who are troubled rest with us when the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven with His mighty angels, 8 in flaming fire taking vengeance on those who do not know God, and on those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ. 9 These shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of His power,

-**Gal 3:24** Therefore the law was our tutor to bring us to Christ, that we might be justified by faith. 25 But after faith has come, we are no longer under a tutor. 26 For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus. 27 For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ.

-**John 17:17** ¶ "Sanctify them by Your truth. Your word is truth.

-**John 8:31** ¶ Then Jesus said to those Jews who believed Him, "If you abide in My word, you are My disciples indeed. 32 "And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free."

- **Deut 4:2** "You shall not add to the word which I command you, nor take from it, that you may keep the commandments of the LORD your God which I command you.

- **Jer 10:23** O LORD, I know the way of man is not in himself; It is not in man who walks to direct his own steps.

-Where were the disciples first called Christians? **Acts 11:26** .....And the disciples were first called Christians in Antioch.

- What is a proof verse that the kingdom has come? **Mk. 9:1** , **Col. 1:13**

- **1Pet 5:7** casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you.

- **Gal 1:8** But even if we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel to you than what we have preached to you, let him be accursed. 9 As we have said before, so now I say again, if anyone preaches any other gospel to you than what you have received, let him be accursed.

-**Heb 4:12** For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

-**Ezek 18:20** "The soul who sins shall die. The son shall not bear the guilt of the father, nor the father bear the guilt of the son. The righteousness of the righteous shall be upon himself, and the wickedness of the wicked shall be upon himself.

- **Col 3:2** Set your mind on things above, not on things on the earth.

-**Ro 1:16** ¶ For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek.17 For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, "The just shall live by faith."

-**Acts 20:7** ¶ Now on the first day of the week, when the disciples came together to break bread, Paul, ready to depart the next day, spoke to them and continued his message until midnight.

-**1Cor 16:1** ¶ Now concerning the collection for the saints, as I have given orders to the churches of Galatia, so you must do also: 2 On the first day of the week let each one of you lay something aside, storing up as he may prosper, that there be no collections when I come.

- **1 John 3:4** ¶ Whoever commits sin also commits lawlessness, and sin is lawlessness.
- 1 John 5:17** All unrighteousness is sin, and there is sin not leading to death.
- **James 4:17** Therefore, to him who knows to do good and does not do it, to him it is sin.
- **Rom 14:23** But he who doubts is condemned if he eats, because he does not eat from faith; for whatever is not from faith is sin.
- **Col 3:17** And whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him.
- **2 John 1:9** Whoever transgresses and does not abide in the doctrine of Christ does not have God. He who abides in the doctrine of Christ has both the Father and the Son.
- **Eph 5:19** speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord,
- **Col 3:16** Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.
- **Mt 7:21** ¶ "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven.
- **Ga 5:4** You have become estranged from Christ, you who attempt to be justified by law; you have fallen from grace.
- **2 Tim 3:16** All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, 17 that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work.
- **2 Pet 1:20-21** knowing this first, that no prophecy of Scripture is of any private interpretation, 21 for prophecy never came by the will of man, but holy men of God spoke as they were moved by the Holy Spirit.
- **2 Cor 5:10** For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, that each one may receive the things done in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad.
- **2 Tim 2:15** Be diligent to present yourself approved to God, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.
- **Prov 28:9** ¶ One who turns away his ear from hearing the law, Even his prayer is an abomination.
- **Prov 28:13** ¶ He who covers his sins will not prosper, But whoever confesses and forsakes them will have mercy.
- **James 2:19** You believe that there is one God. You do well. Even the demons believe--and tremble!

- **Prov 27:17** ¶ As iron sharpens iron, So a man sharpens the countenance of his friend.
- **Prov 13:13** ¶ He who despises the word will be destroyed, But he who fears the commandment will be rewarded.
- **Prov 13:20** ¶ He who walks with wise men will be wise, But the companion of fools will be destroyed.
- **Prov 11:14** ¶ Where there is no counsel, the people fall; But in the multitude of counselors there is safety.
- Where could we go to find the purpose of miracles? **John 20:30-31** And truly Jesus did many other signs in the presence of His disciples, which are not written in this book; 31 but these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that believing you may have life in His name.

- **Psalms 19:7-11** ¶ The law of the LORD is perfect, converting the soul; The testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple; 8 The statutes of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart; The commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes; 9 The fear of the LORD is clean, enduring forever; The judgments of the LORD are true and righteous altogether. 10 More to be desired are they than gold, Yea, than much fine gold; Sweeter also than honey and the honeycomb. 11 Moreover by them Your servant is warned, And in keeping them there is great reward.

- **Psalms 1:1** ¶ Blessed is the man Who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, Nor stands in the path of sinners, Nor sits in the seat of the scornful; 2 But his delight is in the law of the LORD, And in His law he meditates day and night. 3 He shall be like a tree Planted by the rivers of water, That brings forth its fruit in its season, Whose leaf also shall not wither; And whatever he does shall prosper. 4 The ungodly are not so, But are like the chaff which the wind drives away. 5 Therefore the ungodly shall not stand in the judgment, Nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous. 6 For the LORD knows the way of the righteous, But the way of the ungodly shall perish.

- **Proverbs 15:1** ¶ A soft answer turns away wrath, But a harsh word stirs up anger.

- **Proverbs 18:17** ¶ The first one to plead his cause seems right, Until his neighbor comes and examines him.

- **Proverbs 3:5** Trust in the LORD with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding; 6 In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He shall direct your paths.

- **1 Peter 5:8** ¶ Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour.

- **Titus 2:11** ¶ For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men, 12 teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age,

- **Ephesians 6:1** ¶ Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right.
