Shadows of Christ: Isaac

Many Old Testament figures reveal to us a picture of Christ. When Abraham sent his servant far away to find a wife for his son, Isaac, Isaac stayed at home. As Isaac's bride was being brought back to the promised land, Isaac went out to meet her and she said, "Who is that man, walking in the field to meet us?" The servant said, "It is my master" (Gen 24:65, ESV). Likewise, we will be united with Christ on the Last Day, and Christ will come out to meet us. "The dead in Christ will rise first. Then we who are alive, who are left, will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air" (1 Thess 4:16-17).
