Many helping hands will finish this job quickly!

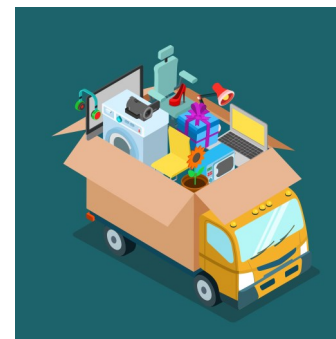
