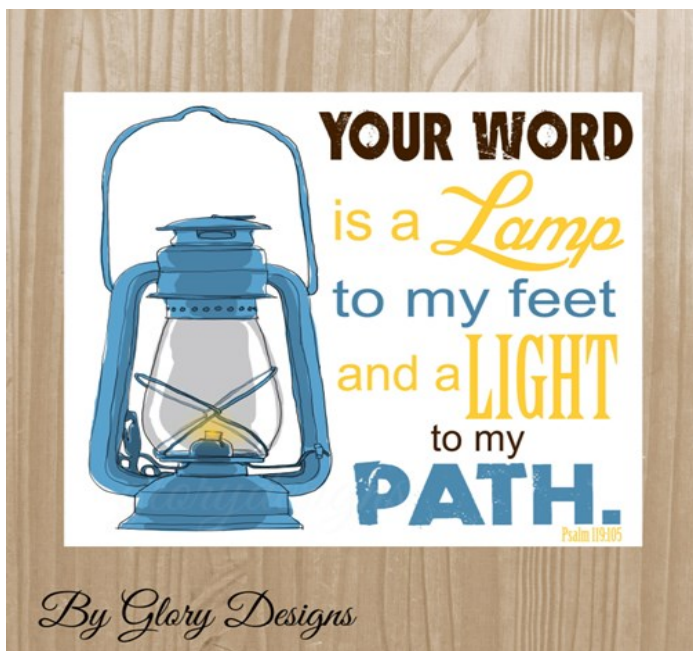
Ministry and Activity

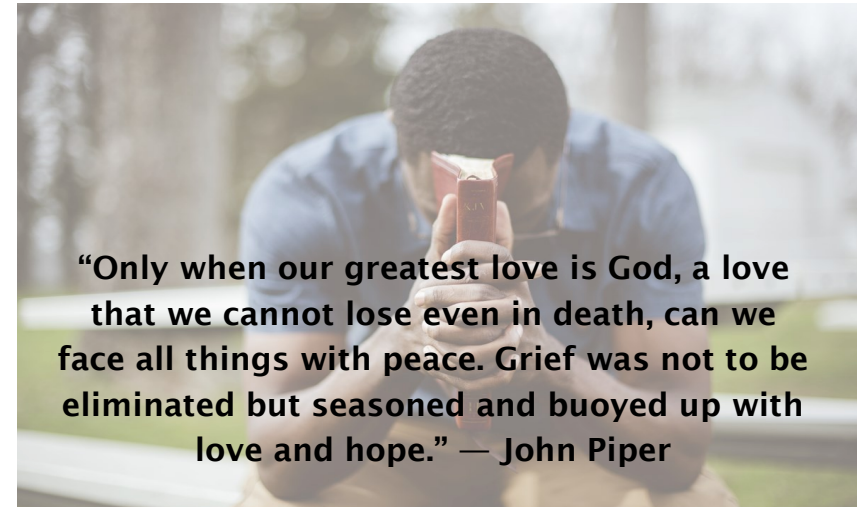
