And when those same brothers come begging for food, he tells them, “As for you, you meant evil against me, but God meant it for good, to bring it about that many people should be kept alive” (Genesis 50:20). Joseph had faith that God was working in him even during the most painful times. That kind of faith will sustain us as well. In the darkest of times, God is still working in you.

**Doyle Brown** is suffering from COPD issues and is being treated by the VA. Please keep Doyle and Cheryl in your prayers.


**Katie Fitch's** back ablation procedure went well. Pray for a quick recovery.
