

EVERY DAY CHRISTIANITY

Introduction

- 1) **Being a Christian is not** like having a job that you do for a certain number of hours a day or week, and the rest of the time you are your “regular self”
- 2) Being a Christian is who you are and your manner of living – it is who and what you are to be every minute of every day (Gal. 2:20)
- 3) The morals you live, the choices you make, the evils you avoid should all be those which a Christian would normally do *at all times and in every place*
- 4) Christianity is an everyday way of life, but do we live as a Christian every day (Eph. 5:16)?
 - a) God blesses us every day (Psa. 68:19; Lk. 11:3)
- 5) Let us do these things and improve our lives as daily sacrifices of service to God

I) SAY SOMETHING TO GOD EVERY DAY

A) Continually in daily *prayer*

- 1) Rom. 12:12; Eph. 6:18; Phil. 4:6; Col. 4:2; 1 Thess. 5:17
- 2) We need to stay in constant communication with God (1 Pet. 5:7; Heb. 4:16)

II) LET GOD SAY SOMETHING TO YOU EVERY DAY

A) Continually in daily *Bible study*

- 1) Josh. 1:8; Psa. 1:2; Acts 17:11; 2 Tim. 2:15
- 2) Our ears and hearts must be constantly open to God’s word (Jas. 1:21-22)

III) DO SOMETHING FOR GOD EVERY DAY

A) Continually in daily *good works*

- 1) Jas. 1:25; Lk. 9:23; Eph. 2:10; Titus 3:8; Acts 9:36
- 2) These good works serve to help others and glorify God (Gal. 6:10; Matt. 5:16)

IV) SAY SOMETHING FOR GOD EVERY DAY

A) Continually in daily *teaching*

- 1) Psa. 72:15; 145:2; Acts 5:42; Acts 19:19; 1 Pet. 3:15
- 2) Teaching is done by words and actions to all those around us (Col. 4:5-6)

V) DO SOMETHING FOR/WITH GOD’S CHILDREN EVERY DAY

A) Continually in daily *edification*

- 1) Acts 2:46; 16:5; Heb. 3:13
- 2) God’s children care about the spiritual welfare of one another (Eph. 4:15-16)

Conclusion

Daily habits of a Christian are hard to break, and that is good when they are godly habits that promote spiritual growth, give aid, teach truth, and strengthen us in the Lord. Practicing every day Christianity transforms us into faithful and effective spiritual servants of our King, Jesus Christ (Rom. 12:1-2).
