<p>Not-so-blind faith:</p> <p>Prior revelation – Gen. 6:5, 9, 13</p> <p>Gen. 11:31, Acts 7:2-4, Gen. 12</p> <p>Gen. 50:24-25</p> <p>Prior Actions – v.31, Josh 2:9-10, Lk. 7:3</p>	<p>"not seen" faith:</p> <p>Flood – v.7</p> <p>Land – not knowing – v.8</p> <p>Future deliverance – v.22</p> <p>What is not seen???</p>

<p>• Moses' faith: v.27</p> <p>–Is it a blind faith because God is invisible? Ex. 3:1-6; 9:27-29</p> <p>–God is not inaudible or unrevealing</p> <p>–By revelation and actions, Moses knew he could trust God</p>

<p>• Faith demands obedience– Heb. 11:7,8,17</p> <p>–(Mk. 16:16, Matt. 28:18-20; Acts 2:38; Acts 22:16; Gal. 3:26-27)</p> <p>• Faith demands endurance – Heb. 12:1-3</p> <p>–Must not "draw back", "cast away...confidence" – Heb. 10:35-39</p>
