## Acts 10:1-8 (NKJV)

*<sup>1</sup> There was a certain man in Caesarea called Cornelius, a centurion of what was called the Italian Regiment,*

*<sup>2</sup> a devout man and one who feared God with all his household, who gave alms generously to the people, and prayed to God always.*

*<sup>3</sup> About the ninth hour of the day he saw clearly in a vision an angel of God coming in and saying to him, "Cornelius!"*

*<sup>4</sup> And when he observed him, he was afraid, and said, "What is it, lord?" So he said to him, "Your prayers and your alms have come up for a memorial before God.*

*<sup>5</sup> Now send men to Joppa, and send for Simon whose surname is Peter.*

*<sup>6</sup> He is lodging with Simon, a tanner, whose house is by the sea. He will tell you what you must do."*

*<sup>7</sup> And when the angel who spoke to him had departed, Cornelius called two of his household servants and a devout soldier from among those who waited on him continually.*

*<sup>8</sup> So when he had explained all these things to them, he sent them to Joppa.*

# Baptism is a burial

**Romans 6:1-4 (KJV)** *What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? 2 God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein? 3 Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death? 4 Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.*
