

What to Expect

We are so proud of you! If you are reading this, that means you have taken the first step toward finding what you have been searching for— whether that be God or a church family. We hope you find that here. **As a church we aim to be a loving group of people serving God.** We also understand that every church functions a little different. In order to help get you acquainted, here is a brief description of the things you will find in one of our services.



Prayer: We pray collectively. A man from the congregation will stand in front of the group and pray; he does this on behalf of everyone. The intent is that we each individually pray silently what he says aloud. Typically, people bow their heads out of respect to God who listens to us. Feel free to “amen” in agreement if you feel so inclined.



Music: Everyone is invited to sing during the song portions of our service. We are not professionals, but we believe God values our singing anyway. All songs will be projected, so please read and sing along as we praise God.



Lord's Supper: During the Last Supper, Jesus concentrated symbolically on two food items: bread and grape juice. He instructed that these represented His body and His blood, respectively, and that the disciples should eat and drink them weekly to remember His death.



Giving: If you're visiting with us, **we are not asking for your money.** As members of this congregation, we choose to give to God every week. While we do this, please fill out a guest card and drop it in the plate as it passes you.



Preaching: The sermon portion of our service will last for approximately thirty minutes. Our goal is to present a message straight from the Bible that will encourage each hearer to be more like Jesus. We hope that you're encouraged to do the same.
