A Life that Glorifies God is...

- **A Life that is Devoted to Worshiping God**
 - “Give unto the LORD the glory due to His name; worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness” (Psalm 29:2).
 - “All nations whom You have made shall come and worship before You, O Lord, and shall glorify Your name. ¹⁰ For You are great, and do wondrous things; You alone are God... I will praise You, O Lord my God, with all my heart, and I will glorify Your name forevermore” (Psalm 86:9-10, 12).

- **A Life that Fears and Obeys God**

- Ecclesiastes 12:13-14

- “Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God and keep His commandments, for this is man's all.
14 For God will bring every work into judgment, including every secret thing, whether good or evil.”



A Life that Glorifies God is...

- **A Life that Causes Others to Glorify Him**

- “You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden. ¹⁵ Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house. ¹⁶ Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven” (Matthew 5:14-16).

A Life that Glorifies God is...

- **A Life that Glorifies God in the Body**

- “Flee from sexual immorality. Every other sin a person commits is outside the body, but the sexually immoral person sins against his own body. ¹⁹ Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God? You are not your own, ²⁰ for you were bought with a price. So glorify God in your body” (1 Corinthians 6:18-20).

A Life that Glorifies God is...

- **A Life that Bears Much Fruit**

- “I am the true vine, and My Father is the vinedresser. ² Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit He takes away; and every branch that bears fruit He prunes, that it may bear more fruit... ⁴ Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me. ⁵ I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing... ⁸ By this My Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit; so you will be My disciples” (John 15:1-2, 4, 5, 8)



A Life that Glorifies God is...

- **A Life that Suffers for the Name of Christ**


- “If you are reproached for the name of Christ, blessed are you, for the Spirit of glory and of God rests upon you. On their part He is blasphemed, but on your part He is glorified.¹⁵ But let none of you suffer as a murderer, a thief, an evildoer, or as a busybody in other people's matters. ¹⁶ Yet if anyone suffers as a Christian, let him not be ashamed, but let him glorify God in this matter” (1 Peter 4:14-16).
