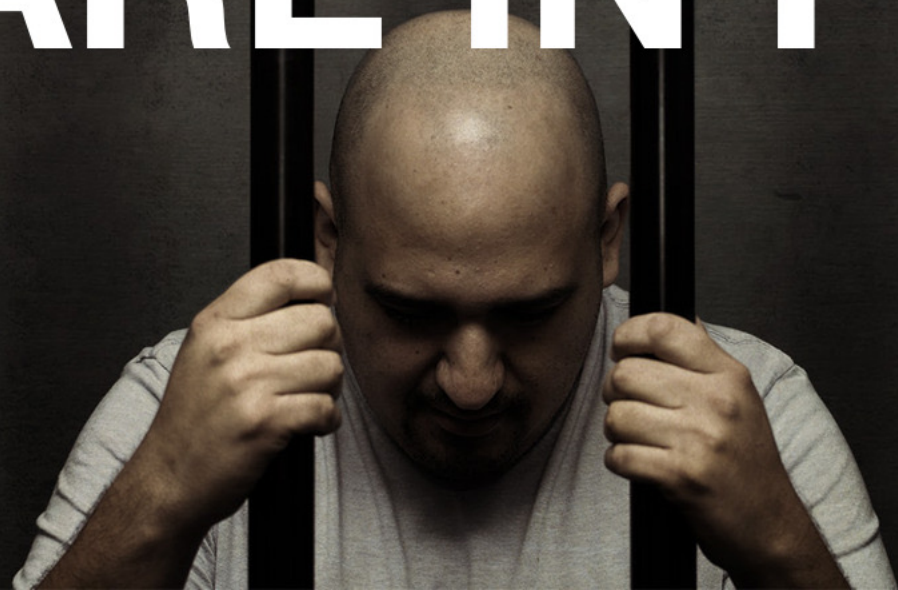

This is not about prison ministries or visiting criminals—those have their place. It's about visiting those who are PERSECUTED for following Jesus.

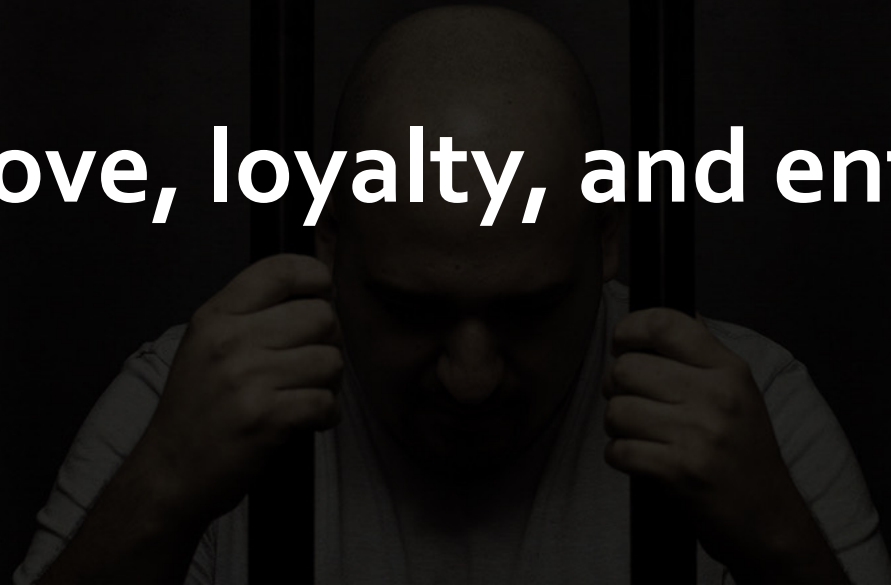

When Visiting Our Spiritual Family in Prison, We Learn...

COMPASSION: pity and concern for the sufferings or misfortunes of others.

SYMPATHY: sharing the feelings of another.

DEVOTION: love, loyalty, and enthusiasm for another.



Why This Lesson?

Our people might not be in prison, but do we do something as SIMPLE as visit those who are in need, have bad health, are weak in the faith, or lonely? This is TRUE religion and a TEST of faith.



Why This Lesson?

Let's be HONEST: If we fail to visit a brother or sister who has health issues, will we visit them in prison? The answer either CONDEMNNS or JUSTIFIES us! (Mt 25)
