

## The Persecution of Jeremiah

1. **Jeremiah 11.21-23** - The people from Jeremiah's own town, Anathoth, want to kill him
2. **Jeremiah 15.15-21** - Jeremiah was persecuted for prophesying.
3. **Jeremiah 18.18** - Judah wants to strike with their tongue at Jeremiah
4. **Jeremiah 20.1-2** - Pashur, a priest and officer in charge of keeping peace, arrests and beats Jeremiah
5. **Jeremiah 26.8ff** - The priests arrest Jeremiah wanting to put him to death. He is saved by Akikam and the elders.
6. **Jeremiah 29.24-28** - Anger over Jeremiah not being rebuked for his negative prophecies
7. **Jeremiah 32.2ff** - Shut up in the court of the guard for speaking against Zedekiah
8. **Jeremiah 36.5, 26** - Restricted from the Temple
9. **Jeremiah 37.4, 13-21** - Arrested and placed in the dungeon then placed in the court of the guard by Zedekiah
10. **Jeremiah 38.1-13** - Jeremiah is arrested for being a traitor and thrown into a cistern to die. An Ethiopian man named Ebed saves him
