3. What does Mary Magdalene think happened when she discovered the open tomb?
4. What evidence do Peter and John discover when they run to the tomb?
5. What new commission does Jesus give them after he appears?
6. What other notable bible characters doubted?
7. What is the difference in a **sign** and a **miracle**?

## For Wednesday night we will finish the gospel accounts by examining Luke's gospel (Read Luke c.24)

1. Why are both an empty tomb **AND** resurrection appearances of Jesus necessary?
2. Why did the women go to the tomb early in the morning?
3. In Luke 24:13-25, how does Jesus teach the two on the road? How does he reveal himself to them?
4. When Jesus appears in the upper room ... why does he emphasize his physical state?
5. How is resurrection and the preaching of repentance for forgiveness of sins connected?
6. 24:49 ... What is the **promise of the father** they await?
7. Outline all the evidence the apostles witness regarding Jesus in Chapter 24.
