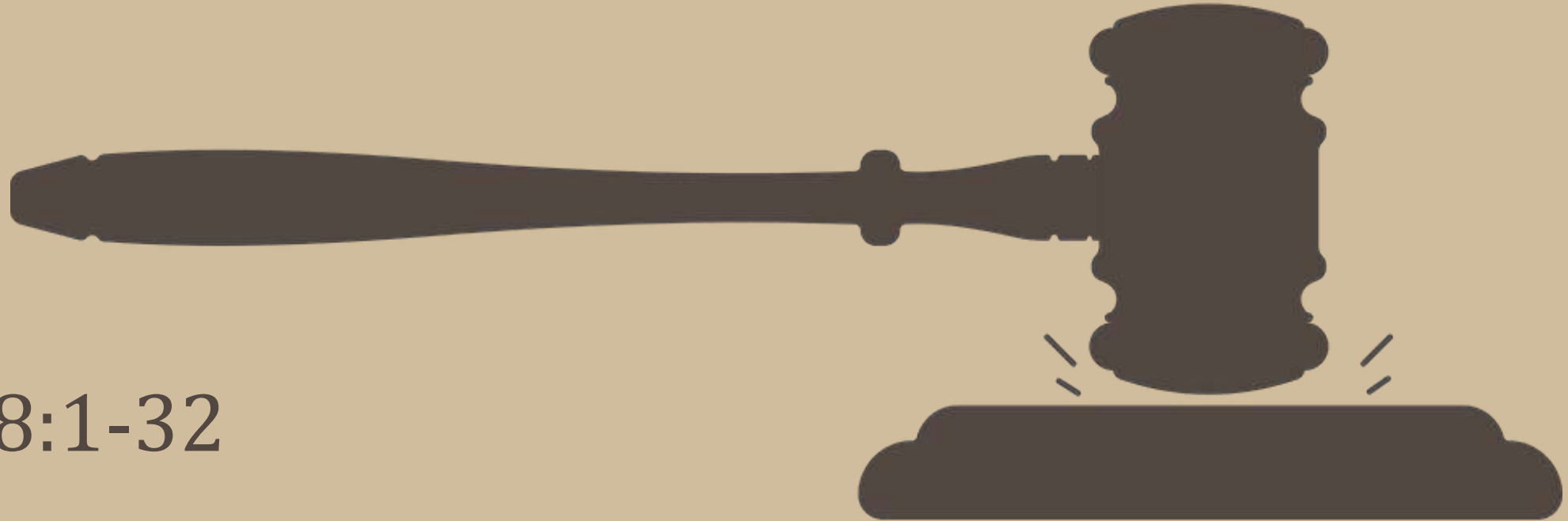

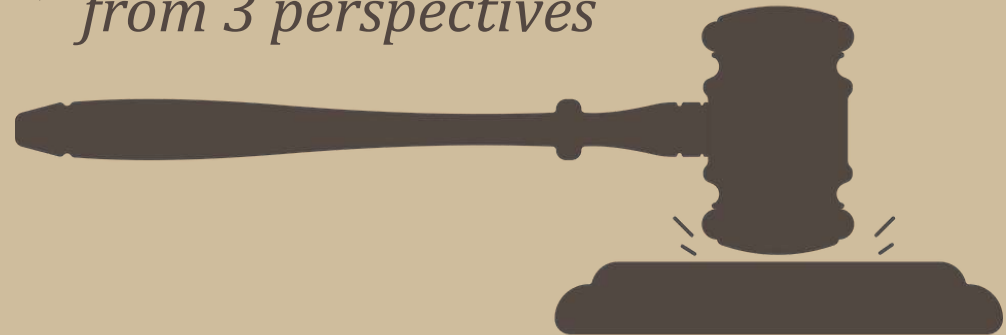
Peter

- *Fearful – verses 17-18, 25-27*

from 3 perspectives



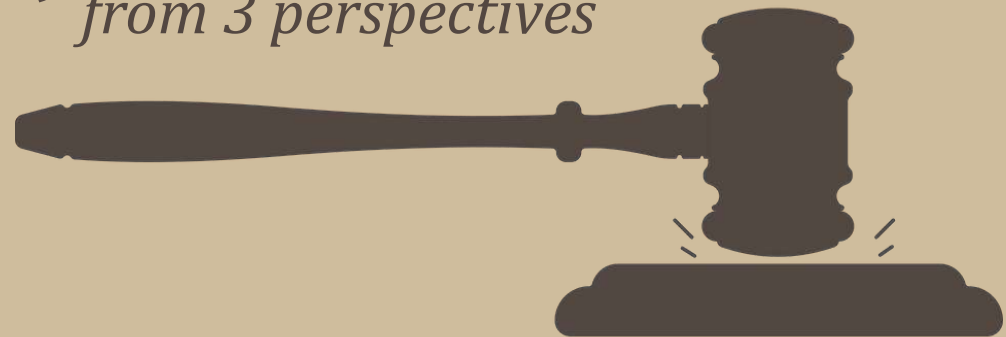
Jews

convinced of Jesus' defeat

- *Intent to kill Jesus – John 5:18, 8:59, 10:31, etc.*
- *Caiaphas' prediction – John 18:14, 11:49-53*
- *Annas' interrogation – verses 19-23*
- *Satan's role – John 8:44, 12:31*

Satan's goal is to rid the world of Jesus and His people – 1 Peter 5:8-10

Jesus

confident & controlled

- *Voluntary surrender – John 18:4-6*
- *Protecting disciples – verses 7-9*
- *Willing to drink the cup – verses 19-23*
- *Affirmation of innocence – vv. 20-23*

Jesus was in control and found peace
in doing the Father's will – John 4:34
