Mary Magdalene

John 20:1-2, 11-18

- She saw
 - *An open grave – v. 1*
 - *Two angels – v. 11-12*
 - *Jesus – vv. 14-16*
- From aimless to on a mission
- Jesus' resurrection gives us purpose and meaning (2 Cor. 5:14-15)



The Ten Disciples

John 20:3-10, 19-23

- Peter and John saw
 - *Open tomb – v. 4*
 - *Grave clothes – v. 5-7*
- The gathered ten saw
 - *Jesus – v. 19*
 - *Jesus' hands and side – v. 20*



The Ten Disciples

John 20:3-10, 19-23

- From fear to joy!
 - *John 16:20-22*
- From hiding to going
 - *Acts 2*
- Jesus' resurrection empowers us to rejoice in hope (1 Pet. 1:3,6)



Thomas

John 20:24-28

- He saw
 - *Jesus – v. 26*
 - *Jesus' hands and side – v. 27*
- From doubt to devotion
 - *"My Lord and my God!"*
- Jesus' resurrection overcomes our uncertainties and doubts
