THINK

- God made us in His own image. How are we like God? Why does it matter?

PRAY

Pray to God together as a family. Focus on creation and your role in being made in His image.

DO

- **Memory Verse:** *God saw all that He had made, and it was very good.* - Gen. 1:31a
- Memorize the Old Testament Books
- Create something (play doh animals, a tower of blocks, cookies, a poem, draw a family portrait, etc...) Afterwards, reflect about what it means to create.
