Abortion

How did we get to this point?

- Fined for harming an eagle
- People spent time / money trying to free two beached whales
- Dog owner tried for starving an animal
- A woman put in her will that her dog must be put to sleep; court overruled: the dog "had a right to live"
- Jan. 22, 1973, nine men robed in black denied this right to unborn infants

I. Biblical Facts Of Life

Life is sacred; gift of God

- Gn.1:26; 9:6
 - Death penalty for murder: life is sacred
 - Man is not an animal
 - Life is a gift of God –

"...nor is he served by human hands, as though he needed anything, since he himself gives to all mankind life and breath and everything" – Acts 17:25

Some philosophy!

"a philosophy of reason will define a human being as life which demonstrates self-awareness, volition, and rationality. Thus it should be recognized that not all men are human . . . It would seem to be more inhumane to kill an adult chimpanzee than a newborn baby, since the chimpanzee has greater mental awareness"

Bible does not distinguish between babe in womb and out

- 2 K.19:3, children come to the birth...
- Job 3:11, 16 (miscarriage: an *infant* that never saw light)
- Ps.139:13-16, formation in womb is an activity of God
 - Continuity of life: conception to birth
 - Not a "blob of protoplasm"

Baby in the womb (1/2)

- Heart (muscle pulsations): 22 days after conception; pumps baby's own blood
- 40 pairs of muscles are developed along the trunk at 4 weeks
- Skeleton is complete and reflexes are present at 6 weeks
- Can experience pain from 6th week.
- Brain waves detectable at 43 days

Baby in the womb (2/2)

- Palm and fingerprints form after 8 weeks
- Squints, swallows, retracts tongue at 9th and 10th week
- Arms / legs move, sucks thumb, inhales and exhales amniotic fluid at 11th and 12th week
- All organ systems present and functioning
 sleeps, wakes, tastes, hears after 12
 weeks
- Recognizes mom's voice: week 20

If you came upon an immobile body and you yourself could not determine whether it was dead or alive, I think that you would decide to consider it alive until someone could prove it was dead. You wouldn't get a shovel and start covering it up. And I think we should do the same thing with regard to abortion" - R. Reagan

Luke 1-2

- Luke 1:36
 - conceived son; 41, babe
 - an unborn child, embryo, fetus;
 a newborn child, an infant, a babe" (Th.,105)
- Lk.2:12, 16
 - the difference between an unborn and a newborn is time, not worth [Lk.18:15, infants; Ac.7:19, babies]

Mt.7:12, the basic principle

- Hysterotomy (C-section): baby left to die
- Salt poisoning: takes about 1 hour; burns off outer layer of baby's skin
- D & C (dilation and curettage): sharp, loopshaped knife cuts piece by piece
- Suction: ripped apart by suction machine
- Partial birth abortion: all of baby except head is delivered; doctor inserts scissors into base of skull, sucks out brains

Ro.1:31, without natural affection

- 'Unfeeling' (BDAG); without normal human affection, without love for others (L-N).
- Abortion, exposure, infanticide, etc.

James 2:26 — body, spirit, death, life

- 'body' without 'spirit' = death
- body' with 'spirit' = life (person)

If baby is a new living creature at conception, spirit is present

II. Arguments To Justify Abortion

1. Gn.2:7

"Adam did not become alive until God breathed breath of life into him; since baby doesn't breathe until he leaves womb, baby has no soul and can be killed w/o guilt" (Gn.2:7)

- Not parallel. Adam had no life until God breathed into him; a baby is alive and growing from moment of conception
- Baby's oxygen is supplied through umbilical cord. If alive, spirit (Ja.2:26)
 - Peter Singer

2. Ex.21:22-25 (1/3)

"In OT, if baby is killed, a fine is imposed; if mother is killed, capital punishment; therefore, unborn babies are not persons"

- Proves too much . . . 20-21 / 28-29 [32]
- "And yet no harm follows": may mean the child is miscarried, but does not die
 - Fined for injury (early delivery)
- "If any harm follows": if either child or mother die, the guilty party must die
 - Death penalty (reckless homicide)

2. Ex.21:22-25 (2/3)

- Ex.21 discusses <u>accidental</u> damage; abortion is <u>deliberate</u>
- "Life for life" is unborn baby a 'life'?
 Summary: describes premature birth
- (1) "her children come out": birth, not death
- (2) "no harm": no serious damage
- (3) "pay": for any remuneration

2. Ex.21:22-25 (3/3)

"It has sometimes been claimed by those in favor of abortion that the unborn child is not really considered as an individual here: but that is not the point of this passage . . . The destruction of the unborn child was regarded by the Hebrews as an instance of the most barbarous cruelty, calling down God's judgment (2 Ki. 15:16)"-cole [Am. 1:13]

3. What if mother's life in danger?

"Protection of the life of the mother as an excuse for an abortion is a smoke screen. In my 36 years of pediatric surgery, I have never known of one instance where the child had to be aborted to save the mother's life. The doctor will either induce labor or perform a Caesarean section. His intention is to save the life of both the mother and the baby. The baby's life is never willfully destroyed because the mother's life is in danger" – C. Everett Koop, Surgeon Gen.

4. What about rape / incest?

- Less than 1 % of abortions occur because of rape, incest, deformity, and threat to mother's life
- Judges declare death penalty for rapists, 'cruel and inhumane,' but authorize death penalty for innocent baby in womb

5. "What about birth control?"

- If it prevents conception, not abortion
- If it causes early miscarriage, it is abortion

6. "It's the woman's body..."

If baby is an appendage, why . . .

- 50% males?
- many have different blood types than moms?
- all have unique genetic fingerprints?
- are there two bodies?

Susan Smith murdered her children

- "I'm personally against these murders, but it's her right to choose"?
- Faulty premise: 1 Co.6:19-20

7. "You can't legislate morality"

All laws regulate morality

- Freedom of speech; assault; murder...
- Should there be a law against shooting abortion doctors?
- How should Congress spend its time?
