3 Biblical Accounts

- Something to be learned from each one
- Matthew 17:1-9
- Mark 9:2-10
- Luke 9:28-36

1. Peter, James, and John

- Says a lot about these three
- Out of view of other apostles
- Potentially caused jealousy
- Who is the greatest? (Mark 9:33)
- James and John's mother (Matt. 20:20)

2. Jesus, Moses and Elijah

- Moses' face shone when he spoke with God (Exodus 34:29)
- Jesus' face shone because he is God
- Moses has made it to the promised land (Deut. 34:1)
- They spoke about His departure (Luke 9:30)

3. Peter Speaks

- Peter recognizes Moses and Elijah
- Peter, James, and John were asleep (Luke 9:32)
- Peter would rather speak than remain silent
- Zeal doesn't make you right

4. God Speaks

- Peter is cut off
- Apostles are silent now, they will speak later (Acts 4:33)
- God doesn't have to say Jesus' name
- Jesus is more important than Moses and the prophets (Jeremiah 31:31)

5. Jesus Comforts The Apostles

- Jesus often comforts people who are afraid
 - Matthew 9:22
 - Mark 10:46
- Jesus is the apostles' friend

6. Tell No One

- This was only for the apostles to know about
- He says he will be risen from the dead
