- Ac.10:33 So I sent to you immediately, and you have done well to come. Now therefore, we are all present before God, to hear all the things commanded you by God
- 1 Co.1:29 ...that no flesh should glory in His presence
- 1 Tim.5:21 I charge you before God and the Lord Jesus Christ and the elect angels that you observe these things without prejudice, doing nothing with partiality
- Also 6:13; 2 Tim.2:14; 4:1

We are **now** in presence of God

 - They complain . . . God heard

God speaks to us

- Nu.24:13
 - Cliches sound good, but do not substitute for right actions

God knows us

- Jn.2:24-25
 - He knows us better than we know ourselves
 - Ps.50:21, These things you have done and I kept silence; You thought that I was just like you; I will reprove you and state the case in order before your eyes

God wants us to win

- Ac.7, Stephen's death
 - Jesus knows
 - Jesus cares
 - Jesus encourages
 - Jesus accepts him
 - What else matters?

III. Impact of His Presence

- 1. Discipline, Mt.18:...15-20
- 1-14: previous context: our sins against others
- 15: now turns to sins of others against us. Lv.19:17-18
 - a. Explains how principle of 10-14 works
 - b. You: a brother has sinned; you must act
 - c. Alone: avoid publicity
 - d. Aim: gain (win) your brother
 - e. Involve others only when private attempts have failed (v.16)
 - f. Church (local congregation), 17
 - g. Sinner's refusal to repent . . . fatal

1. Discipline, Mt.18:...15-20

- 1-14: previous context: our sins against others
- 15: now turns to sins of others against us.
- 18: future perfect tense (cf. NASB):
 - Shall have been bound
 - Shall have been loosed

Church carries out heaven's decision; not heaven ratifying church's decisions.

Heavenly decision preceded church action.

1. Discipline, Mt.18:...15-20

- 1-14: previous context: our sins against others
- 15: now turns to sins of others against us.
- 18: future perfect tense (cf. NASB)
- 19: Father's participation: perfect harmony between heaven / earth
- 20: "I am there in the midst of them..."
 - In smallest possible company, offering greatest possible confession, reaping sweetest possible communion.
 - He knows ... cares ... commands ... judges. Rv.2:4

2. Worship, Mt.26:26-30

Ps.100:2. (1 Sm.3:9)

Ac.2:42

Ac.10:33

- 1 Co.11:17-20, come together...for worse... divisions...not to eat Lord's supper
 - They chewed / swallowed, but lost all connection with the Lord
 - 33-34…lest you come together for judgment
 - He sees, He knows, He judges

3. Christians, Mt.28:20 "I am with you always..."

Ac.18:9-10

- 2 Co.2:10, Now whom you forgive anyth., I also forgive. For if indeed I have forgiven anything, I have forgiven that one for your sakes in the presence of Christ
 - 1:23 began section invoking God as Witness; concludes by invoking Christ as witness of his genuine forgiveness
 - There IS an all-seeing Eye

4. Death, Ps.23:4

- "I walk through the valley . . . '
- 2 Co.4:14, knowing that He who raised up the Lord Jesus will also raise us up with Jesus, and will present us with you
- 2 Th.1:9, These shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of His power
