(John 13:35; 1John 2:6) Are we so busy with our own interests that we don’t make time to love others? (Philippians 2:1-4) Everywhere we go we should walk in the image of Christ (Christlikeness) and be committed to “seeking first the Kingdom of God and His righteousness” (Matthew 6:33) so others will have no doubt that we know His saving grace through His Son.
